



REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Register early. Registrations are processed in the order received. No spaces will be held without full payment. Students who register by mail or fax should assume acceptance unless otherwise notified. Students ages 13 years of age or older are eligible to enroll in most of our adult classes; call the registration office for more information. It is the responsibility of the student to appear in class on the correct day and hour without additional notice. There are no prerequisites for admission and all classes are open to beginners unless otherwise noted. You and/or your work may be pictured or reproduced in Studios on the Park promotional materials. When students are to provide their own materials, a supply list will be sent.

Three easy ways to register:

- In Person. Stop by Studios on the Park at 1130 Pine Street. We are open Thursday - Sunday from 12 pm to 6 pm. Call for Friday & Saturday evening hours.

Payment Options:

- Make checks or money orders payable to: Studios on the Park (a \$35 fee is charged for returned checks.)
- Enter your Visa and MasterCard information on the registration form. Discover and American Express are not accepted.

Studios on the Park is not responsible for missed classes. If a student is unable to attend a class period for any reason, Studios on the Park is not responsible for providing makeup.

Cancellations and Refunds: Occasionally, classes are cancelled due to insufficient enrollment. In such cases, Studios on the Park will notify you approximately 48 hours before the class begins and the full class fee will be refunded, either by check or credit card, depending on your form of registration. Studios on the Park reserves the right to substitute instructors.

Classes: All customer initiated cancellations are non-refundable but if they are made at least 1 week before the class begins, credit may be received in the form of a Studios on the Park Gift Card, redeemable for a future class. Under no circumstances will tuition be transferred to another term. No cash refunds are available.

Late Registrations: Students may register late for any class in which space is available. However, fees will not be prorated.

Waiting Lists: Waiting lists are maintained for full classes. Students must request that their names be placed on the waiting list, and will be contacted if space becomes available in the requested class.
